

- **9:00am till 10:00am:** Registration of attendees and Squadding of teams.
- **10:00am:** First shots shortly after.
- **Average time on course:** Two and a half to three and a half hours to complete the course.

TRAPPER INFORMATION

General

- Wear ear and eye protection at all times during shooting.
- Stay behind shooter at all times- DO NOT go past shooting stands.
- Do not touch clay throwers- in case of malfunction, notify management: Josie (337) 303-5348 or Rusty (337).
- Before you leave, pick up all empty shotgun shells and throw in trash barrel.

Trapper Instructions

- Before the shoot, look at station sign to determine whether to pull a true or report pair. Push button #1, look at the target. Push button #2 and look at it. If one machine malfunctions, you know which one it is. Do this once.
- Once the team is at your station, they will want to see a pair. This is called a “view pair.” Make sure they are all ready, and show them the pair. Only one free look per team.
- *True Pair*- push the #1 and #2 buttons at the same time when the shooter calls pull.
- *Make sure you press and hold buttons until you SEE the target come out.*

Scoring Instructions

- Call out *DEAD* for each target hit and *LOST* for each target missed so the shooter can hear you. Make sure you pay attention to whether or not they hit the target. If a shooter disagrees, give it to him/her. We’re here to have fun and make money.
- Place an “X” for each target hit and a “0” for each missed target on the correct station of the scorecard. For example, if the shooter hits the first target and misses the second, record it as X, 0. If they miss the first target and hit the second, record it as 0, X.
- *Thrower Malfunctions*- If a machine malfunctions, DO NOT APPROACH. Attempt to throw again. Contact management if machine fails to work.

Malfunctions

- If the shooter’s gun does not go off, you may re-throw just the target he/she did not get to shoot. Some shooters may prefer to shoot the whole pair again. Either way is fine. Same goes for machine malfunctions. If a target comes out broken, you may either re-throw the pair or just the one that is broken. Ask the shooter what he/she’d prefer.



Wilderness Gun Club, LLC

Rules

1. Anyone caught disrespecting the grounds or operating in an unsafe manner will be escorted off of the property and not allowed to return.
2. Members must accompany their guests at ALL times. Any particular guest may come 3 times annually.
3. Gun actions must be open at all times when not shooting.
4. No Alcohol consumption permitted before or during shooting.
5. Do not load your gun until on a shooting station.
6. Treat every gun as if it is loaded.
7. Do not load more than two shells at a time - do not load more than one shell on skeet station 8 or on singles.
8. Keep loaded gun pointed down range.
9. No rifles or pistols permitted.
10. No tactical or high capacity shotguns permitted. Field/Clay Models only.
11. No gun larger than 12 gauge permitted.
12. No release triggers permitted.
13. In the event of a gun or ammunition malfunction, keep gun pointed down range until unloaded.
14. No ammunition permitted with shot larger than #7 1/2 or load heavier than 1 1/8 oz of shot and 3 1/4 dram.
15. No steel shot permitted.
16. Always keep ammunition of different gauges in separate bags.
17. Do not walk in front of or touch any trap machines.
18. Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all shooters, spectators, pullers, and trappers.
19. No pets allowed.
